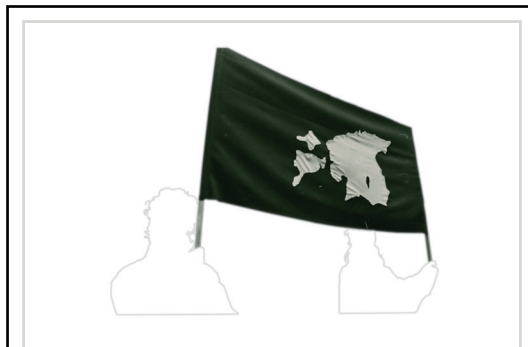
COVID-19 & state of emergency

- 12.03.2020: state of emergency is declared
- 26.03.2020: investment of 125 million euros into Enefit280 oil shale plant construction confirmed
- 28.03.2020: open letter of protest by youth organizations
- 26.04.2020: FFFE tries to go to court to annul the permission to start construction of the plant
- 12.05.2020: inquiry to the Commissioners of the EU
- ...events are still unfolding

- the investment into oil shale plant during the state of emergency
- the inability to protest in public during the state of emergency
- disregard for future generations and future environment
- far-reaching decision is being made in the state of elevated political power
